

## Sports Flooring Installer (Journeyman)

Operations - Aurora, Ontario

### Position Overview:

As a **Flooring Technician (Journeyman)** you will construct wooden and other types of sports flooring according to specifications with the goal of contributing to the construction and maintenance of robust and long-lasting buildings and products. Your job will entail working in diverse settings to produce steady and functional sports and performance and equipment products. You are an individual with great hand dexterity and an eye for detail. You will also have good knowledge of carpentry and flooring materials. Working with little supervision while following all health and safety standards is essential. This is a union position belonging to **UBCJ Local 27**.

### Responsibilities:

- Compliance with company health and safety training and reporting requirements
- Complete all aspects of subfloors, hardwood, rubber, vinyl flooring and sport equipment
- Complete some aspect of finish carpentry, hardware, trim work
- Complete all aspects for painting gamelines and artwork graphics
- Other duties assigned include machine operation of lifting equipment and concrete coring.

### Education and Experience

- High school diploma/GED
- Two+ years related experience
- First Aid skills and/or certificates are considered assets
- WHMIS, Working at Heights, Elevated Lift and other typical safety certifications are considered assets
- Valid driver's license with clean driving record
- Physically fit and able to lift up to 50 lbs
- Certificate of qualification-Red Seal are considered an asset.

### Knowledge/Skills/Abilities:

- Ability to use a variety of tools and machines such as forklifts, telehandlers, drills, grinders, saws etc.
- Ability to read and understand building and shop drawings
- Effectively communicate both verbally and in writing
- Capable to receive, interpret and act on directions in a timely and efficient manner
- Ability to work under pressure and make decisions based on sound judgment and reasoning
- High attention to detail
- Strong time management and organizational skills
- Capacity to work both independently and under direct supervision in a busy environment

### Effort:

- 44+ hour/week position involving long periods of standing and physical labour
- Safety oriented in dealing with hazardous activities including lifting heavy objects, and the use of potentially dangerous tools, such as saws and drills

### Working Conditions:

- Flooring Technicians work and perform maintenance on both existing buildings and construction sites and as such may work in dirty, dusty, muddy or noisy conditions. Job site cleanliness is policy.
